













## Regional Training Workshop for the Volta Basin Stakeholders on Impact-Based Flood Forecasting and Generation of the Warning Bulletins



Stakeholders from the Volta Basin countries took part in a regional 5 day training workshop on the impact-based flood forecasting system and bulletin tool integrated into the <u>myDewetra-VOLTALARM platform</u>.

The workshop occurred in June 2023 in Cocody (Abidjan), Côte d'Ivoire and aimed to warn and alert stakeholders of the Volta Basin in real time of disasters linked to flood hazard for early action to protect lives, properties and livelihood. Over five days, participants were provided with theoretical and practical knowledge on flood forecasting, as well as opportunities to test among all stakeholders the bulletin tool developed according to roles and procedures previously defined through the myDewetra-VOLTALARM platform.

## WMO MCH server delivery and MCH Database training

While delivery of the MCH server to six countries was on-going, WMO together with VBA and six countries organized the training on the WMO Meteorology Hydrology and Climatology (MCH) database management system. The training covered theoretical knowledge and hands-on experience in defining stations and variables, data importation, quality control, analysis, and generating hydrological products. Participants from the national and regional agencies involved in flood and drought monitoring learned how to create variables, login credentials, server accessibility, rating curves, transformational tables, and hydrological models.

Once the MCH database management system is up and running, the processed data and information will be visualized under the MyDewetra VOLTALARM Early Warning System (EWS) for national and regional agencies involved in monitoring, forecasting, and warning services for floods and droughts.
